## What is this product?

### Type

The product is a share class of the sub-fund Franklin Shariah Systematic Global Equity Fund (the "Fund") which is part of Franklin Templeton Shariah Funds, an open-ended investment company with variable capital (SICAV), qualifying as a UCITS.

### Term

The Fund has no maturity date. The Fund could be closed under the conditions laid down in the current prospectus of the Fund.

### Objectives

#### Investment Objective

To seek long-term investment growth, through growth of capital.

#### Investment Policy

The Fund mainly invests in Shariah-compliant equity and equity-related securities that are constituents of the MSCI ACWI Islamic M-Series Index (USD) (the "Index"). The Index includes securities from global markets, including Emerging Markets.

The Fund uses a quantitative investment approach, meaning it selects investments based on data and models. The strategy employs a proprietary quantitative selection process using a multi-factor model to assign a score based on certain factors like quality, value, momentum and alternatives factors. All investment decisions are made by the Investment Manager based on the scores assigned by its proprietary model.

**Derivatives and techniques** The Fund may use derivatives for reducing risks (hedging) and costs, and to generate additional income or growth.

**SFDR category Article 6** (does not promote environmental and/or social characteristics or have a sustainable investment objective under EU regulations).

**Base currency** US dollar (USD).

**Benchmark(s)** MSCI ACWI Islamic M-Series Index (USD). Used for performance comparison and as a universe to select investments. Although the Investment Manager is constrained by the benchmark in its portfolio positioning/composition, the Fund is not obliged to invest in all constituents of the Index or replicate the weightings of securities within the Index.

The Fund is actively managed.

### Share Class Policy

The income received from the Fund's investments is accumulated with the result of increasing the value of the shares.

### Buying and selling shares

You may normally buy or sell shares on any day the New York Stock Exchange is open for business.

### Intended retail Investor

Investors who understand the risks of the Fund and plan to invest for at least 3 years. The Fund may appeal to investors who:

- are looking for long-term investment growth
- are interested in exposure to Shariah-compliant equity markets as part of a diversified portfolio
- have a medium risk profile and can tolerate moderate short-term changes in the share price

**Product availability** The Fund is available to all investors with at least basic investment knowledge, through a wide range of distribution channels, with or without the need for advice.

**derivatives:** Financial instruments whose value is linked to one or more rates, indexes, share prices or other values.

**emerging markets:** Markets of less economically developed nations, such as some nations in Asia, Africa, Eastern Europe and Latin America.

**equities:** Securities that represent partial ownership of a company.

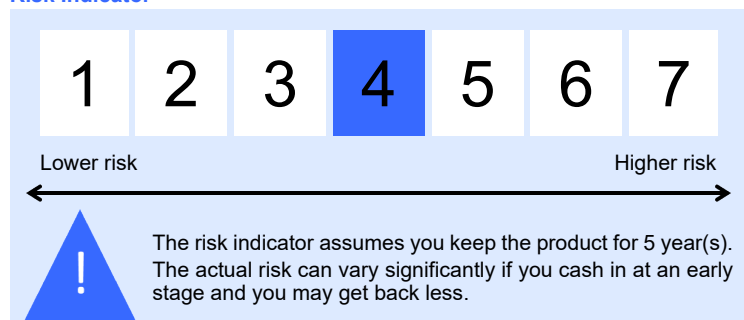

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk Indicator



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets.

## Performance Scenarios

## What happens if Franklin Templeton International Services S.à r.l. is unable to pay out?

Franklin Templeton International Services S.à r.l. ("FTIS") is the management company of the Fund, but the assets of the Fund are held separately from FTIS by the depositary. J.P. Morgan SE, Luxembourg branch, as the appointed depositary, is liable to the Fund or its shareholders for losses caused by its negligent or intentional failure to fulfill its safekeeping or record-keeping obligations (cash could however be lost in case of default of the depositary or its delegates).

There is no compensation or guarantee scheme protecting you from a default of the Fund's depositary.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

### Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario
- USD 10 000 is invested
