### Objectives and Investment Policy

Franklin Gulf Wealth Bond Fund (the “Fund”) aims to maximise total investment return by achieving an increase in the value of its investments, earning income and realising currency gains over the medium to long term.

The Fund pursues an actively managed investment strategy and invests mainly in:

- debt securities of any quality (including lower quality and securities in default) issued by governments, government-related entities or corporations located in Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) member countries, and issued in any currency

The Fund can invest to a lesser extent in:

- debt securities issued by governments, government-related entities or corporations based in the wider Middle East and North Africa regions, or issued by supranational entities (like the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development)
- structured products (such as Sukuk which under normal market conditions may represent 10% to 30% of the Fund’s net assets)
- derivatives for hedging and investment purposes
- mortgage- and asset-backed securities

In making investment decisions, the Fund’s investment team uses a mix of detailed research into securities, macroeconomic views and quantitative analysis. The majority of their investment decisions are based on their detailed

research into economic trends in countries across the globe and each debt security. They conduct thorough analysis to assess each securities overall contribution to portfolio risk and investment return, before deciding whether it should be included in the portfolio. The Fund may distribute income gross of expenses. Whilst this might allow more income to be distributed, it may also have the effect of reducing capital.

The benchmark of the Fund is the FTSE MENA Broad Bond GCC Issuers Index. The benchmark is used solely as a reference for Investors to compare against the Fund’s performance, and the benchmark is neither used as a constraint on how the Fund’s portfolio is to be constructed nor set as a target for the Fund’s performance to beat. The Fund can deviate from the benchmark.

You may request the sale of your shares on any Luxembourg business day.

For the distribution share class shown in this document, dividend income is distributed to shareholders.

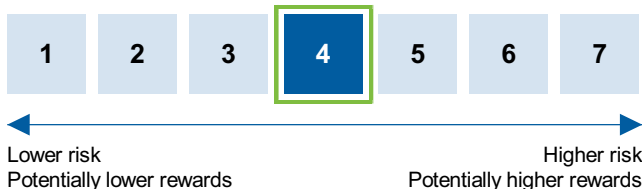

#### Terms to Understand

#### Why is the Fund in this specific category?

The Fund invests mainly in debt securities issued by any type of entity located in Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) member countries. Such securities have historically been subject to price movements, generally due to interest rates or movements in the bond market. As a result, the performance of the Fund can

fluctuate over time.

#### Risks materially relevant not adequately captured by the indicator:

**Credit risk:** the risk of loss arising from default that may occur if an issuer fails to make principal or interest payments when due. This risk is higher if the Fund holds low-rated, sub-investment-grade securities.

**Foreign Currency risk:** the risk of loss arising from exchange-rate fluctuations or due to exchange control regulations.

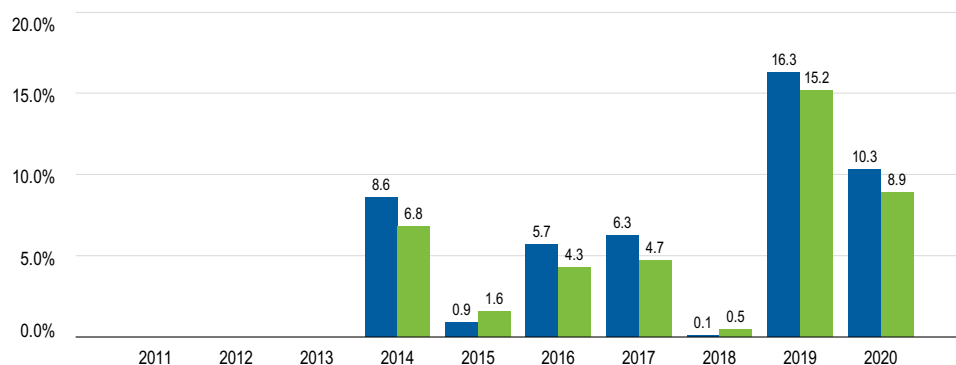
